Applicants for admission to the School of Journalism who are not current University of Regina Students.

Who Should NOT Submit this Form?

- Students wishing to **begin** the pre-journalism part of the program at the University of Regina should contact The Admissions Office, University of Regina, Regina, SK S4S 0A2; 306-585-4591 regarding admission to the **Faculty of Arts through the University of Regina, Campion College, Luther College or the First Nations University of Canada** (as a pre-journalism student).
- Current University of Regina students applying to the School of Journalism should contact the School of Journalism or the Faculty of Arts to obtain an **Internal Application Form**.

Application Fee: There is no fee to apply for re-admission. A non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 (subject to change without notice) must be paid by all new undergraduate applicants. Payment may be made by Visa or Mastercard by completing the Credit Card Payment section on the application form. Payment may also be made by cheque or money order, payable to the “University of Regina”.

SUBMISSION OF TRANSCRIPTS AND DOCUMENTS**1. Post-Secondary Transcript(s) of Marks:**

- One official Post-Secondary Transcript – transcripts must be up-to-date, include all courses that you have completed, as well as any in which you are presently enrolled. All transcripts must be originals, and sent directly to Admissions from the institution(s) you attended.
- If you are applying to the Bridging Year for Masters, your transcripts must indicate that an undergraduate degree **has already been conferred, OR you must enclose a letter** from the institution indicating **the date that an undergraduate degree is expected to be conferred**.

PROGRAM CHOICE

BA in Journalism:

The BA in Journalism is available to those who have completed the pre-journalism stage – at least two years of specific university courses – with a minimum academic average of 70 per cent. **All courses must be completed by April 30 of the year in which admission is sought.** The following is a list of the pre-journalism requirements [all are one-semester (3 credit hour) courses]:

Pre-journalism requirements:

- ENGL 100
- Any course in MATH, STAT, CS (except CS 100), **PHIL 150**, 352, 450, 452, 460, SOST 201, ECON 224
- Any course in ART, ARTH, CTCH, FA, FILM, MU, MUCO, MUEN, MUHI, MUTH, THAC, THDS, THEA or THST
- Any course in ASTR, BIOL, CHEM, GEOL or PHYS that has a laboratory component, or GEOG 121
- One of the following: **ENGL 110**, RLST 245 or 248, PHIL 100 or SOST 110

- Any two language courses in the same language other than English
- Any course in ANTH, GEOG 100, 120 or RLST (except RLST 181, 184, 186, 188, 281, 284, 288)
- Any course in HIST or CLAS 100 or IDS 100
- Any course in ECON, IS, JS, PSCI, PSYC, SOC, SOST, WGST or GEOG (except GEOG 100, 120, 121, 309, 321, 323, 325, 327, 329, 333, 411, 421, 423, 429, or 431),
- Any course in INA, INAH, INCA, INDG, INHS or any one of ENGL 310AA-ZZ; GEOG 344; HIST 310; JS 350, 351; PSCI 338 or SOC 214 or other courses approved by the Faculty of Arts as having substantial Indigenous content, including special studies course
- THREE courses chosen from THREE of the following groups:
 - Any ECON course
 - A course emphasizing Canadian history
 - A course above the introductory level emphasizing Canadian politics and government
 - A course dealing with the media in a social science context : SOST 110, INCA 283, PSCI 434
- Six additional electives

All students who complete the above requirements will be considered for admission; however, students are advised to complete ENGL 110 and PHIL 150 among their core requirements. They are further advised to complete their second language requirement in French. Finally, students are advised to choose some of the following courses as electives: SOC 100 and/or SOC 203; PSCI 100 and/or PSCI 230; ENGL 251, 351.

Subtotal: 70% PGPA on pre-journalism required to apply for admission.

Students who complete the pre-journalism program must apply for admission to the School of Journalism.

Bridging Year for Master of Journalism:

The Master of Journalism is available to those who already have an undergraduate degree in journalism or have completed the Bridging year. **THE PREVIOUS DEGREE MUST BE CONFERRED BY THE SPRING CONVOCATION OF THE YEAR FOR WHICH ADMISSION IS SOUGHT.**

Note: If your degree has not yet been conferred, you must attach a letter from your Faculty Office indicating that an undergraduate degree is expected to be conferred at Spring Convocation this year.
